## General Park Rules

### Clubrooms

The Clubrooms will be open for the use of the Toilets only. There will be many areas within the clubrooms that will be alarmed. This area is not a children's playground so please ensure that your children are not in this area.

### Alcohol

We have an Alcohol License for the park throughout this event. There are some very stringent laws that we have to abide by. One of these is that there is to be no BYO alcohol onto the park. Any teams caught breaking this rule will immediately be removed from the tournament.

### Glass

Broken glass is a very real danger to all so we ask that no glass is brought onto the park.

## Health and Safety

---

### Car Parking

Due to ongoing road works on Sawyers Arms Rd, parking may be limited. There will be the usual off street parking but if you are parking adjacent to the back of clubrooms please be aware that there is a diamond set up beside the fence. Park here at your own risk.

### Creek

The creek that runs between Papanui domain and the high school is a hazard especially to young children. Please ensure that your children are supervised in this area.

### Grand Stands

There are several grand stands placed around the park. Please ensure that you take care when getting on and off these. These are also not a piece of children's play equipment.

## **Railway**

While the railway line is not a part of the park, this area contains many hazards, so please take care when looking for foul balls in this area

## **Batting helmets**

Please ensure all players use batting helmets when batting.

## **Foul Balls**

While we are playing softball the balls are anything but soft. Please be aware around the games that there may be a lot of foul balls and assist others around you to let them know when they are coming.

## **Bases**

There will be fixed bases on the skin diamond and floating bases on the grass diamonds. Please ensure that all players are aware of this and use appropriate techniques for running the bases.

## **Outfielders**

While we have attempted to spread the diamonds out there may be instances where out fielders from 2 diamonds may be within each other's fielding areas. Please ensure these players help each other out vocally when a ball is coming their way.

**Overall we attempt to provide a safe environment but hazards will always be present at a softball park. It is everyone's responsibility to ensure the safety of others.**
